«DEVELOPMENT OF PHARMACOECONOMICS AND PHARMACOEPIDEMIOLOGY IN THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION»

Pharmacoeconomics after being a new overseas development have come into the daily praxis of the public health care services and pharmaceutical business. Introduction of the list of constitutive drugs essential to preservation of vital functions of the human organism into the program of costly nosologies, substantiation of the list and purchases of drugs at the federal and regional levels as well as at the level of a local medical institution are taking place with a glance at the results of the pharmacoeconomical studies. Pharmacoeconomical models, particularly those containing modular units substantiating managerial solutions, are more and more in demand. We have already drugs that have been introduced into medical practice at prices calculated using pharmacoeconomical methods.

The congress is devoted to discussing of these and a lot of other topics. It is to be held for the 6th time (they were formerly held in Moscow, Kazan, Yekaterinburg and Samara) and is in the focus of attention of the professional audience.

CONGRESS PROGRAM

Plenary sessions

- Federal and regional programs of drugs supply: positioning of pharmacoeconomics and pharmacoepidemiology.
- Pharmacoeconomic analysis as a mandatory component in forming the list of constitutive drugs essential to preservation of vital functions of the human organism.
- The health care service budget: an expenditure optimization model or a dynamic model of the missed opportunities. What kind of information do the people taking decisions need?
- Nosologies registers: what kind of information they provide and why it is so much needed. The first experience in pharmacoeconomical assessment of the domestic register.
- Costly nosologies: priorities of drugs supply; is it possible to expand the list of nosologies?
- Regional programs for drugs supply development
- Pharmacoeconomical models of assessing the demand for drugs at the regional level and at the level of a medical institution.
- Educational programs with focus on practice.

Sectional sessions

- Pharmacoeconomics of high cost nosologies (oncology, diabetes mellitus, rheumatoid arthritis, disseminated sclerosis, etc...)
- Pharmacoeconomics of widespread diseases (cardiovascular, gastroenterological, neurological, etc...)
- Interactive practical training “Innovations in treatment of diabetes mellitus and in oncology: cons and pros” (pros – effective therapy, cons – higher costs (have we considered all the expenses?))
- Pharmacoeconomics of “social” diseases and “social challenges”: alcoholism, tobacco smoking, HIV/AIDS, narcomania, tuberculosis

- Pharmacoeconomics and pharmaeepidemiology at the patient care institutions: practical training for head doctors. How is demand for drugs to be calculated
- IN FOCUS – regional session: shaping impact of different patterns of drug treatment on regional budgets (demonstration of pharmacoeconomical models for the domestic health care service)
- Production potential of pharmacoeconomical research for manufacturers of generic drugs
- Practical training for health care specialists and the staff of pharmaceutical companies: how results of pharmaceutical research should be evaluated and presented
